Student Spring Uniforms

Learners will be allowed to begin wearing the Spring uniform upon returning from Spring Break on Monday, April 10th. The Spring uniform consists of the maroon polo shirt, khaki pants, a black belt, and black shoes. The maroon polo shirts can be purchased at Flynn O'Hara. *Please note that learners must continue to wear their winter uniform until 4/10.*

PHS Workforce

PHS is recruiting individuals who are looking to learn hands on training in basic ecology, landscape maintenance and tool & equipment operation. This is a paid six-week training upon completion trainees will be placed in full time landscaping jobs.

COVID-19 Information

- If your student has had a close contact exposure to a COVID-19 positive individual, your student does not need to quarantine, but rather wear a mask for 10 days following the close contact exposure. Testing is also recommended within 48 hours of the close contact exposure and again five days following the close contact exposure. Students may request an over-the-counter COVID-19 test from the school nurse to take at home.
- If your student is experiencing one or more COVID-19 symptoms, please keep them home from school and seek testing.
- If your student develops one or more COVID-19 symptoms at school, your student will be sent home from school with an over-the-counter COVID-19 test to take at home.
- If your student tests positive for COVID-19, they must isolate for 10 days. Please notify the school and the school will send you detailed isolation instructions.

PowerSchool & Kickboard Utilization

1.Please be sure to check your learners' grades on PowerSchool to see any assignments they need to make-up. We recommend doing this on a weekly basis as educators update grades every week.

2.Please check Kickboard to see how your learner is being celebrated or corrected throughout the week. When learners receive 6 corrective behaviors in one week a student will receive a detention

Technology Message from IT Team

Please see the message below that was sent to all learners from the IT team.

Learners are all responsible for the equipment Boys' Latin provides for us. Learners should not leave their Chromebooks or AC adapters laying around unattended. If they are lost, the learner and their family are responsible for replacing it.

If a Chromebook is lost, please let us know ASAP by email at support@boyslatin.org. Do not wait a day, a week, a month to say something. When we are informed it is missing, we will check to see if we can locate it. If we cannot, you are responsible for replacing it. Do not take someone else's Chromebook because you lost yours. This is considered theft and will result in immediate disciplinary action.

To purchase a new Chromebook you will need to go to the <u>Boys Latin web site</u> (under Families --> Important Information --> Chromebook Fees) and choose the option for "Lost/Stolen Chromebook". Thanks for your time.
