
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

Summits on	6 th and 7 th Grade Summits
Bullying and Sexual Harassment	Last week we held summits with all 6 th and 7 th graders to help Dismantle the Man Box and the stereotype that Aggression Equals Violence. Students watched a video on what Bullying is and what it is not. They also watched a video on two well-known rappers going against the idea that aggression and violence should be glorified. This will be an ongoing conversation with our young kings because the idea that being aggressive and resorting to violence is something that is glorified in the music that some students listen to and encouraged in certain settings. 8th Grade Summits

Last week we held an 8th grade summit on the topic of respecting woman and sexual harassment. We want to Dismantle the Man Box stereotype that women should be treated as objects and are of less value than men. We showed our warriors a video of a woman casual walking in New York and what she experienced for just being a woman. We had a conversation on what can be disrespectful or deemed as sexual harassment. Please talk with your warrior about what it means to show women respect. Chat rooms and other platforms Please talk with your warrior about participating in online group chats (Discord, Instagram, etc.) There have been some instances of students engaging in inappropriate conversations about each other and staff on these platforms. We have worked to disable many of these platforms on school laptops. Some students have been using Boys' Latin laptops to engage in these conversations. Per our laptop acceptable use policy:

- Hate mail, chain letters, harassment, discriminatory remarks, and other antisocial behaviors are prohibited on the network.
- The unauthorized installation of any software, including shareware and freeware, for use on Boys' Latin computers is prohibited.
- Use of the network to access or process pornographic material, inappropriate text files (as determined by the Technology department), or files dangerous to the integrity of the local area network is prohibited.

• Boys' Latin's network may not be used for downloading entertainment software or other files not related to the mission and objectives of Boys' Latin for transfer to a user's home computer, personal computer, or other media. This prohibition pertains to freeware, shareware, copyrighted commercial and non-commercial software, and all other forms of software and files not directly related to the instructional and administrative purposes of Boys' Latin.

If students violate this policy, then students will be suspended or put up for expulsion. Please talk with your warrior about the academic or legal consequences that they may have to deal with if they engage in this behavior.

Laptop Charging Please make sure your warriors' laptop is charged each night and they bring it to school everyday. Make sure your warrior brings their ID every morning for attendance purposes. If your warrior did not get their picture taken or lost their ID they can see our IT specialist on Tuesday and Thursday during their lunch period.

Student Attendance and Early Dismissal	<u>Arriving on Time</u> Students are late if they arrive after 7:59AM . It is imperative that students arrive before 8AM so they can get to class on time. <mark>If students arrive after 7:59 they must enter through the Visitor Main Entrance.</mark> You can always see your students' attendance on PowerSchool.
	- <u>Early Dismissals</u> Students are NOT allowed to be dismissed by phone or email. Only a parent or an emergency contact can pick-up a student for an early dismissal. <u>All early dismissals must occur before 2:30PM.</u>
Dismissal	Please do not double park your car on Callowhill Street . It has caused a very dangerous situation for our students who are walking home and catching public transportation. We also want to respect neighbors and neighborhood traffic flow. We understand that parking is limited, but please DO NOT double park.
