

Section 504 Notice

Any student, employee or parent who has a mental or physical impairment which substantially limits one or more of a person's major life activities is eligible for services and accommodations under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Section 504 states that no otherwise qualified individual with a disability can be excluded from or denied benefits of any program receiving federal financial assistance.

Boys' Latin of Philadelphia will provide to each handicapped student without discrimination or cost to the student or family, those related aids, services or accommodations, which are needed to provide equal opportunity to participate in and obtain the benefits of the school program and extracurricular activities to the maximum extent appropriate to the student's abilities.
