Office Hours for Student Support

To provide students with additional academic support, we have scheduled Office Hours for teachers on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday afternoons. All 9th-grade students are rostered into an Office Hour cohort (4-8 students) one day a week with an individual teacher. Additionally, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders who are earning below a 2.0 GPA (C average) have been added to rosters for Office Hours.

Students may check with their assigned cohort and visit other teachers for help with a pass. In addition, 9th-grade students who are maintaining a GPA higher than 2.3 (C+ average) are permitted to check-in for their Office Hour and then be dismissed. As Office Hours fulfill Leadership Academy credit, it is mandatory for students to take part in Office Hours by completing assignments and getting the extra help to improve their grades.
